

DIY Instructions – Framily Promposal Kit

Salad Corsage

- 1. Cut out a 1.5-2 inch circle from cardboard
- 2. Tear up lime green tissue paper into small pieces and crinkle
- 3. Glue crinkled tissue paper to one side of the cardboard circle until you can't see any more cardboard
- 4. Add your favorite toppings
 - 1. Glue to add small red pompoms to look like tomatoes
 - 2. Cut up small pieces of purple ribbon and glue on top to look like onion add dark purple marker if you want to added depth
 - 3. Use cut up light brown pipe cleaners to look like croutons
 - 4. And use a black marker to add dots to look like olives
- **5.** When your project is dry, flip it over. Cut 8-10 inches of ribbon. Find the center of the ribbon and attach it to the back of the corsage with glue.

Spaghetti Corsage

- 1. Cut out a 1.5-2 inch circle from cardboard
- 2. Cut tan yarn into two strings
- 3. Put glue on the cardboard and swirl the first string around to create your first layer of spaghetti. Add more glue, then add the second string to layer your pasta.
- 4. Lightly color the strings with a red marker to look like marinara sauce
- 5. Glue to add small red pompoms to look like meatballs
- **6.** When your project is dry, flip it over. Cut 8-10 inches of ribbon. Find the center of the ribbon and attach it to the back of the corsage with glue.

Breadstick Boutonniere

- 1. Take 2 light brown pipe cleaners and twist them tight together.
- 2. Cut the doubled up pipe cleaners into 3 pieces repeat this step twice.
- **3.** Take a doubled up 4inch by 4inch piece of tissue paper and glue the 6 breadsticks partially off one corner of the tissue paper.
- **4.** Once dry you can wrap the tissue paper around the breadsticks and glue it into place.
- 5. Take a 4 inch piece of ribbon find the center of it and glue it on to the back of the breadstick bundle bring it around the front of the breadsticks and tie it into a bow
- 6. Use dark brown and yellow markers to add color and depth to the breadsticks

Mint Boutonniere

- 1. Cut out a 1.5-2 inch circle from cardboard
- 2. Take 5 Andes mints and glue them perpendicular around the edge of the cardboard forming a star.
- 3. Repeat step 2 in a way that covers the gaps from the first layer of mints.
- **4.** To form the inside of the flower take 3 Andes mint wrappers and glue the short end of them together in a row.
- 5. Fold the long side of the glued together wrappers in half
- 6. Once folded make small cuts along the entire length of one side of the wrapper
- 7. Take these wrappers and roll them into a circle.
- 8. Glue the circle of wrappers into the middle of the boutonniere

PROM Spelled Out in Breadsticks

- 1. Grab your delicious fresh breadsticks from your local OG or bake 'em yourself at home.
- 2. Lay out 4, poster boards (at least 14 X 8 in size) on a flat surface. One letter will be added to each.
- 3. Use hot glue on the posters to hold your breadsticks in place.
- **4.** Use 25 breadsticks to spell out P-R-O-M. You will need:
 - 1. P: 5 breadsticks
 - 2. R: 6 breadsticks
 - 3. O: 6 breadsticks
 - 4. M: 8 breadsticks
- 5. Gather your "framily" for a delicious promposal!
